

How to get to Chania

There are two international airports on Crete: Chania Airport (CHQ) and Heraklion Airport (HER) .

Chania Airport is located in the north-west of Crete on the 'Akrotiri' peninsula, a few kilometers east of the city of Chania. Heraklion Airport is approx. 150 km further east, also on the north coast of the island near the city of Heraklion.

Direct flights to Crete are offered from most major European airports from April to November. The flight duration to Crete from the UK is about 4 hours. You can find flight connections for Chania airport [here](#) and for Heraklion Airport [here](#).

How to get to Chania town from the airport

From Chania Airport to Chania Town

There are 3 transfer options to get from Chania Airport to Chania Town; taxi, private transfer or bus. Taking a taxi or private transfer will only take 15 minutes and you'll pay approximately 25-30 € depending on the time of year. Alternatively, the bus is a solid budget-friendly choice (approximately 2.50 €) and it takes 25 minutes. Here is the [link](#) for public bus services. Also, [here](#) are some useful info.

From Heraklion Airport to Chania Town

There are 3 ways to get from Heraklion Airport to Chania city; taxi, private transfer or bus. Taking a taxi costs approximately 150 € and takes around 1h 45m.
